We expect an attendance of between 250 and 300 guests. This annual event will raise funds for the Junior League's community work and the JLT's partnership with the George Brown Foundation, specifically the Junior League of Toronto Culinary Scholarship.

Our inaugural event, held last year, hosted by Chef Christine Cushing, a trailblazer in the Canadian food scene for over 20 years and a George Brown graduate, celebrated the success of George Brown culinary graduates. Ten amazingly talented chefs and assistants prepared exquisite tasting plates for over 200 guests complimented by a variety of stellar wines provided by Noble Estates Wine & Spirits.

This year, our event will celebrate women in food and wine and showcase chefs, food purveyors and wine experts who support and celebrate women who are making a significant impact in today's food industry. Our goal is to sponsor 10 female graduates from the Assistant Cook Extended Training (ACET) program. This program is administered by the George Brown Foundation and works in cooperation with CAMH (Center for Addiction and Mental Health) and is part of George Brown's Augmented Education program which supports people with mental health or addiction histories to prepare them for employment.
